AWARDS: Ribbons : 1st through 6th place. Championship will be given to the highest combined score of two classes in each division. Must show in at least two classes in same division for this award.

FOOTING: 2 RINGS: (A) All weather, standard arena; (B) Clay-sand, standard arena. WARM-UP area: clay-sand, fenced in. Intro + Training 1 & 2 will ride in upper clay/sand arena "B" (standard size) If numbers warrant, ALL classes may be in upper arena.

RULES: Based on USDF. All riders **must** wear protective headgear when mounted as per farm rule. Management reserves the right to add or divide classes. Pets must be leashed. PARK ONLY in designated areas. NO CAR PARKING BETWEEN BARN & NO TRAILERS IN BARN AREA without PERMIT. (\$35.00 FEE)

ENTRIES OPEN: January 28, 2012
CLOSING DATE: February 11, 2012

IMPORTANT: Entries must be postmarked by February 11, 2012
\$10.00 LATE FEE for any entry postmarked or sent after closing date.
Post entries taken if times available at \$5.00 additional fee per class.
Refunds: less \$20.00 office fee before closing date; stalls only after closing date.

Directions: From I-75 & SR 50, go west (toward Brooksville) two miles; turn right (north) on High Corner Road. Go one mile to Wildlife Lane; turn right (east) and continue @ 1 ¼ miles (becomes a limerock road) to Fannin Hill Road. Turn right (south). Lower barn is 2nd gate on left, near barns. Trailer parking & day parking is 3rd gate on left
From Brooksville turn east (toward I-75) at the light at Truck Route 50/98 & U.S. 41; go to third light (Hess station-50/98) bear to right, continue @ 5 miles to light at CR 541; go 1 mile to High Corner Road, turn left (north) and continue as above.
