

2008 LAJUF HUNTER/JUMPER CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

PLEASE NOTE: You MAY enter other divisions by riding N.A.G. (No Award Given) Call 352-799-0509 for info.

LEADLINE & WALK: Open to riders 10 & under who have not shown at the trot in any horse show. Open to horses or ponies. Cannot cross enter at this show with any other classes. Judged on EQUITATION in both classes. Safe dress, approved hard hat and paddock shoes or boots required.

WALK-TROT / HUNTER: Open to riders 14 & under who have not shown at the canter. Judged on manners and suitability of mount. Trotting preferred over walk. May choose poles on ground or 10" cross-rails. Canter is penalized. Safe dress required (approved hard hat and paddock boots). Cannot cross-enter with any other division.

CROSS RAILS HUNTER & EQUITATION: OPEN TO VERY BEGINNER RIDERS who have not shown over fences above 18". MUST trot in 1st fence of all lines, may canter out. Can cross-enter with HOPEFUL only. No green horses in U/S class. Proper dress required.

HOPEFUL HUNTER & EQUITATION: (18" Schooling Hunter) Horses or Ponies; no restrictions as to previous height. Horse/rider cannot show in any class higher than 2' at this show. MUST trot in, canter out. Professionals may ride Hunter but NOT Equitation classes.

LONG STIRRUP-SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER & EQUITATION: 18" – will be split Long & Short if numbers warrant. May cross enter with HOPEFUL and PRE-CHILDREN'S/ADULT Divisions.

PRE-CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER & EQUITATION: (2') Open to riders who have not shown above 2'3 within 10 yrs. May NOT cross enter with Children's/Adult or Modified Children's/Adult. Proper dress required. No professionals.

MODIFIED CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER & EQUITATION: (2'3-2'6) Horse/rider combination may not cross enter with Pre-Children's/Adult or Children's/Adult at this show. Proper dress required. No professionals.

CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER & EQUITATION: (2'9 or 3') Open to JUNIOR OR ADULT AMATEURS; no distance changes for ponies. Judged on manners, performance and soundness. Proper dress required. **Choose height.**

LAJUF HORSE MEDAL: (2'9) Open to JUNIOR (14 & UP) or ADULT AMATEUR riders. No distance changes for Ponies for adults. May be required to return for additional individual work. Proper dress required.

BABY GREEN HUNTER: (2' to 2'3) Open to horses or ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing fences 2'3 or higher. Trotting and cantering judged equally; smoothness and consistency paramount. Proper dress required.

LOW HUNTER: (2'3 or 2'6) Open to horses or ponies of any experience. Judged on manners, performance & soundness. No distance changes for ponies. **Choose height.** Proper dress required.

SCHOOLING HUNTER: (2'9 or 3'3) Open to horses or ponies of any experience. Judged on manners, performance & soundness. **Choose height.** Proper dress required.

PONY HUNTER: (2'3 or 2'6) Open to ponies only. To be judged on manners, performance & soundness. Proper dress.

LAJUF PONY MEDAL: (2'3) Open to riders under 18 on ponies over a course of not less than 8 fences. May be required to return for additional tests. Proper dress required.

FIELD HUNTER & CROSS COUNTRY HUNTER: Judged on manners, jumping form and way of going on outside course. In addition, in Cross Country Hunter, "Pairs" judged on keeping a safe distance of 4-6 strides between horses.

LOW JUMPERS: !: Clean rounds only (no jump off); Class 2 & 3, Tbl 2,2b
All other Jumper classes: Table II, Sec.I (Timed 1st round) ; OR: Tbl II, 2b

2'3 LOW JUMPERS: (2'3) Open to horses & ponies. H/R combination may not cross enter with ANY other jumper division at this show. May do hunters and equitation.

2'6 TRAINING JUMPERS: (2'6) Open to horses & ponies. Cannot cross enter with 2'3 Jumpers.

SCHOOLING JUMPER: (2'9 or 3') Open to horses or ponies; Cannot cross enter 2'3 jumpers. No restrictions as to previous experience. **Choose height.**

OPEN JUMPER: (3'3 or 3'6) Open to horses or ponies; cannot enter 2'3 Jumpers. No restrictions as to previous experience. **Choose height.**

Horses must enter at least three shows in a division to accumulate Year End Award Points in that division and fees paid before points will count.

DRESSAGE DIVISIONS

Due to variations of judging, points will be kept by percentages, divided by the number of times class is entered, the winner being the horse with the highest percentage.

INTRO LEVEL: Walk-Trot classes. Divisions will be split if numbers warrant. Only Intro A & B will count toward Year End Awards. Prix-Capriilli is a separate class. (A test done at Walk-Trot with three jumps)
