FOR DIRECTIONS: Use ONLY those on our Website – ALL others take you up Remington Road, which is wrong!

NOVICE LEVEL:

Dressage Test: 2006 Novice Test A; Jumps 3' Max. X/C Time: 350 mpm

BEGINNER NOVICE:

* Dressage Test: 2006 Beginner Novice Test B; Jumps 2'6 Max. X/C Time: 325 mpm

PRE-BEGINNER NOVICE

* Dressage Test: 2006 Beginner Novice Test B; Jumps 2'3 Max. XC Time: 300 mpm

ENTRY LEVEL:

* Dressage Test: 2006 Beginner Novice Test B; Jumps 21" Max.; X/C Time: 275 mpm

WALK-TROT:

Dressage Test: 2007 USDF Intro B; Jumps 10" Maximum. Walk or Trot - Not timed.

If you need a dressage test, please send a self-addressed, stamped envelope

ENTRIES: \$80.00 per division. MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM. Limited to 70 horses. All changes, missing Coggins or signatures will be levied a \$5.00 office charge per missing item.

STABLING: Per Stall: **(May: \$25.00; December: (two-day) \$40.00 (from 12:00 noon Friday - end of event). Entries must be sent together to be stabled together.** PLEASE CLEAN STALLS. Tack stalls available, indicate on entry form. Grounds fee for non-stabled horses: \$10.00 per day.

PARKING: No Trailer Parking in Barn area w/o permit. **Park trailers in trailer field or \$25.00 fee will be imposed.** No vehicles between barns.

AWARDS: Prizes & 6 ribbons per division. Divisions will be split if sufficient entries. Please list date of birth & level of experience (otherwise may be put in more experienced division). Separate ribbons for Dressage.

TEAMS: Can be mixed levels, 3 or 4 riders. \$5.00 per rider additional entry fee. Names must be submitted before dress rides on morning of event. Team medals to first place team and ribbons 2 - 6 place, based on best 3 rides.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE: DRESSAGE: 8:00: Novice, Beginner Novice, PRE-Beginner Novice, & Entry: LOWER Dressage Ring 'A'.

WALK-TROT may be held in UPPER Dressage Ring at approx. 10:00. Walk-Trot will complete Dressage, Stadium & XC at upper rings before Novice begins XC. Novice through Entry STADIUM will be held in LOWER show ring 'B' - times are posted and are on a first-come, first-served basis in the particular time slot, same order as dressage. CROSS COUNTRY will start approximately 1:00 p.m. with Walk-Trot, followed by Novice, Beginner Novice, Pre-Beginner Novice and Entry. Please note on your entry if you are riding two horses, & notify office if there is a conflict.

COGGINS: CURRENT COGGINS MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY! \$5.00 fee will be imposed if copy of Coggins missing.

RULES: Based on USEA; final decision at discretion of Ground Jury. Exceptions: Riders may finish cross-country if eliminated, other than dangerous riding. **For Walk-Trot 12 & under only:** Standing martingales & kimberwicke bits allowed for safety, & dressage tests may be read.

DRESS CODE in effect, including VESTS and ARM-BANDS, and shirts with sleeves on cross country.

COURSE OFFICIALLY CLOSED: 12 days before event. Schooling will be allowed after completion of event at no charge. (Responsible adult or coach must be present). ACCOMMODATIONS: Hampton Inn (352/796-1000); Best Western (352/796-9481); Day's Inn (352/796-9486)

Six Campsites, with electric available at \$25.00 Friday through end of event; tent-sites: \$12.00 (for two people). Book Early!

DIRECTIONS: From SR 50/98 & I-75, go two miles west to High Corner Road. Turn right (north), go one mile to Wildlife Lane, turn right. Continue east (road becomes shell) 1 1/4 miles to mailboxes at end of road. Turn right, go to first driveway on LEFT for lower barn stabling, 2nd driveway for parking in X/C field, 3rd driveway for top barn & office. See map on our website - DO NOT USE MAPQUEST!

REFUNDS: BEFORE closing date, less \$20.00. After closing date., no refunds given unless entry can be filled (less \$25.00 office fee).
