

2024 LAJUF CLASS SPECIFICATIONS and YEA Divisions

LEADLINE WALK DIVISION (classes 54, 55, 56, 57): Open to riders 8 & under who have not shown at the trot in any horse show.

Cannot cross enter at this show with any other classes. Judged on EQUITATION in all classes. Safe dress, approved hard hat, and paddock shoes or boots required. Leadline Trot, & Poles at Walk will be done individually on lead line in front of judge.

WALK-TROT DIVISION 9 & UNDER (58-61): (Poles or X's – specify on entry) An equitation division open to riders who have not shown at the canter. Judged on manners and suitability of mount in pleasure class; rider's position, balance, and effectiveness in all other classes. Trotting preferred over walk in O/F classes. Continued cantering is penalized in over-fence classes. **NO** cross-entries. **NO** Courtesy circles allowed. Walk-Trot can have two riders on same horse in over-fence classes, as this is an equitation division.

WALK-TROT DIVISION, 10 & OVER (67-70): Same as above, except limited to riders 10 & over.

HOPEFUL CROSS RAILS HUNTER & EQUITATION (32-37): Flat classes at Walk-trot-canter; can only cross-enter with Cross Rails Division (26-31); no cross-entries with Hopeful Verticals. **MUST** trot in 1st fence of all lines; may trot or canter out. No Professionals.

HOPEFUL VERTICAL HUNTER & EQUITATION (38-41): 18" Horse/Rider combination cannot show in any class exceeding 18". All Hopeful Vertical classes **MUST** trot in 1st fence of all lines and **MAY** trot or canter out. Cannot X/E with Hopeful Cross Rails or regular Cross Rails division. Flat classes at walk, trot & canter. Proper dress required. Professionals may ride only in Hunter classes.

CROSS RAILS HUNTER & EQUITATION (26-31): Open to **VERY Beginner Riders** who have not shown above 18". **MAY** trot in and canter out **OR** **MAY** trot or canter entire course. Can cross-enter with Hopeful Cross Rails only. Flat classes at walk, trot & canter. Courtesy circle not required in consideration of saving time.

MULTI-TALENTED EQUINE (62-66): 18", 2' or 2'3" Flat classes: walk, trot & canter. Obedience class based on promptness and smoothness of request. Hunter & Equitation O/F may trot OR canter. Pleasure class emphasis on manners. Jumper class is a Blue-ribbon round; no time taken. (Tbl II jumper rules.) Professionals may **NOT** ride in class 65 (Equitation). All points go to Horse in this division.

CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER & EQUITATION (9-14): 2'6, 2'9 or 3' Open to **JUNIOR OR ADULT AMATEURS**; no distance changes for ponies. Hunters judged on manners, performance and soundness. May not cross enter with Pre-Children's/Adult. Proper dress required. No professionals. **Choose height.**

LAJUF HIGH EQUITATION MEDAL (15): 2'6, 2'9 or 3' Open to JUNIOR or ADULT AMATEUR riders. **NO** ponies due to combinations. May be required to return for additional individual work. May **NOT** cross enter with Low Equitation Medal. Finals will be held at November show Proper dress required.

PRE-CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER & EQUITATION (44-49): 18", 2' or 2'3 Open to Junior or Adult Amateurs who do not show above 2'3 at this show. May **NOT** cross enter with Children's/Adult. Proper dress required. No professionals. **Choose height.**

LAJUF LOW EQUITATION MEDAL (50): 18", 2' or 2'3 Open to JUNIOR or ADULT AMATEUR riders. May **NOT** cross enter with High Equitation Medal. Finals held at November show. Proper dress required. Test is included in original course.

LOW HUNTER (1-4): 2'3 or 2'6 Open to horses or ponies of any experience. Judged on manners, performance & soundness. No distance changes for ponies. **Choose height.** Proper dress required.

SCHOOLING HUNTER (5-8): 2'9 or 3' Open to horses or ponies of any experience. Judged on manners, performance & soundness. No distance changes for ponies. **Choose height.** Proper dress required.

BABY GREEN HUNTER (22-25): 18", 2' or 2'3" Open to horses or ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing fences 2', not over 2'6". Trotting and cantering judged equally; smoothness and consistency paramount. Proper dress required. Flat judged at W-T-C.

OPEN MODIFIED HUNTER: (105-107): 2', 2'3, 2'6 Open to professionals; horses or ponies, no restrictions as to previous height. Judged on manners, performance, consistency, and soundness. Proper dress

WARMUP CLASSES are judged and will receive a BLUE ribbon for scores 75% and over. Open all heights, all day, same horse/rider.

THOROUGHbred INCENTIVE CLASSES: Dressage: Intro-First Level #383-392; Open TB Hunter (201-203): choose height, 2'6 or 3' Open card with respective heights; Very Green Hunter (205-207) at 2'; Hopeful Jumper (274-276) at 2'6; TIP High Point and Champion Awards given by Jockey Club; Not LAJUF.

Participants must report placings to Jockey Club; LAJUF does not. Go to www.tjctip.com

BEGINNER JUMPERS (16-18): 18" ONLY – H/R **CANNOT** cross enter with ANY jumper class above 18". Excessive speed or dangerous riding will be penalized at discretion of Judge (4 or 8 faults). #16 - TBL II (not timed); #17 - TBL II 2.1; #18 – TBL II 2D

All other 1st rounds of Jumper divisions will be Clear Rounds; 2nd class Tbl. II, 2b; 3rd class Tbl II, Sec.1 (except Beg Jumpers) TBL II 2D (paraphrased): **Two phase competition consisting of 5-7 obstacles each. Scored by combining the faults of both phases. Finish line of first phase is start line of second phase. Time starts as horse crosses that line. Time allowed option is available, not mandatory, for first phase.**

LOW JUMPERS (71-73): 2'3" Open to horses & ponies. H/R combination may ONLY cross enter with **TRAINING JUMPER** division at this show. May show hunters and equitation at higher level.

TRAINING JUMPERS (74-76): 2'6" Open to horses & ponies.

SCHOOLING JUMPER (77-79): 2'9 or 3': Open to horses or ponies; No restrictions as to previous experience. **Choose height.**

OPEN JUMPER (80-82): 3'3 or 3'6 Open to horses or ponies; No restrictions as to previous experience. **Choose height.**

3 DRESSAGE DIVISIONS FOR LAJUF YEAR END AWARDS: INTRO, TRAINING, & FIRST LEVEL -

All tests: USDF 2023: or USEA 2022 (Eventing) **INTRO: A, B, C * Training Level: 1-3 * First Level: 1-3**

Horses must enter at least *TWO SHOWS* in a division to keep Year End Award Points in that division.
